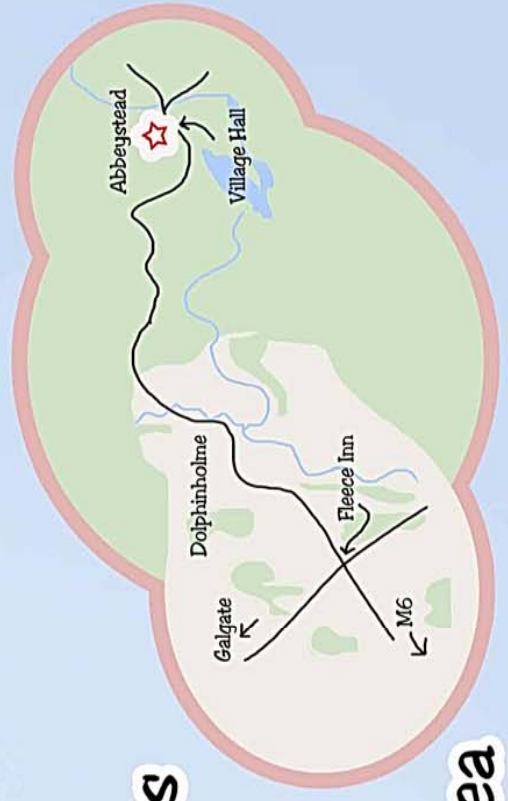

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# Hen Harrier Day – Kid’s Activities

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**Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> August 12-4 pm**

Abbeystead Village Hall

In an effort to make our event as educational and family-friendly as possible we have a number of activities for younger wildlife lovers.

## **Poster Competition**

We encourage the children to make posters celebrating endangered animals in advance of the event so that we can display them in the hall. The Hen Harrier would be the most fitting example of an endangered animal, but it would be good to have other posters too. We suggest picking [examples](#) in the British Isles. If children wished to make a poster about an animal that was already extinct that would also be fine; again we suggest [an animal now extinct](#) from Britain.

The **first prize** for the winning poster is a **family ticket to Dalton safari Zoo**.

## **Wildlife Explorer Walk**

We will have a treasure hunt along a trail lasting at least 30 minutes that will include identifying wild birds, mammals and butterflies. We will have materials that help the children understand and explore the local ecology and unique characteristics of the Forest of Bowland.
